PCAL Division Placements for SPRING SPORTS 2018-2019

The new Pacific Coast Athletic League (PCAL) has completed its process for assigning its schools to its Divisions for its inaugural season of Spring Sports 2018-2019. The PCAL is a merger of the 31 schools of the current MBL and MTAL, to be joined by both St. Francis SCP and CEIBA College Prep of Watsonville as well as the new Rancho San Juan HS in Salinas when it comes on line in 2019-2020.

The process of assigning schools to divisions for Spring 2018-2019 began with a survey of coaches and work by an Athletic Director Committee in each sport, then to a joint MTAL-MBL Merger Committee, then to the PCAL Athletic Director Council, with the final decisions then by the PCAL Board of Managers.

The guiding principle for division assignment is to make each of those divisions as competitive as possible in each sport and gender, with the most competitive teams in the Gabilan division, the next most competitive in the Mission division, then so on to the Cypress and Santa Lucia divisions. The number of divisions in each sport depends on the number of PCAL schools that will compete that sport as well as how the competitive lines fall.
